



Art Committee Meeting Minutes November 7, 2018

Call to order at 7:05 p.m.

On a motion by Vicky Bush-Joseph and seconded by Susan Blumberg-Kason, the minutes of the August 9 meeting were unanimously approved.

On a motion by Vicky Bush-Joseph and seconded by Susan Blumberg-Kason, the minutes of the September 25 special meeting were unanimously approved.

On a motion by Johanna Delaney and seconded by Susan Blumberg-Kason, the minutes of the October 4 special meeting were unanimously approved.

Time Capsule for Trees

The committee discussed the spring art installation. Karen Keefe will reserve one of the Library's display cases for March/April to promote the installation and call for contributions. She will ask Christine to work with Jeremiah on getting images of the sculpture that better represent how items will be displayed.

Keefe informed the committee that Christine Esposito had secured a commitment of \$6,000 in sponsorships. Keefe will invite Esposito to one of the Art Committee's spring meetings. Margaret Carsello Chiappetta recommended the project as a sponsorship opportunity to Chase Bank.

Zhou Brothers Installation Update

Keefe informed the committee that the Library is getting a proposal for new lighting fixtures for the top of the stairway, near where the Zhou Brothers artwork will be installed. She will try to coordinate the two installations to limit disruption to the Library.

Rotating Exhibits

The committee reviewed the list of potential exhibitors.

On a motion by Vicky Bush-Joseph and seconded by Susan Blumberg-Kason, motion to invite Katrina Davis-Salazar to exhibit in February 2019 was unanimously approved. Cheryl Eden will be Katrina's library liaison.

Margaret Carsello Chiappetta will curate and create documentation to exhibit this summer as part of the restoration of the Windhover sculpture at Hinsdale Middle School. Instead of a traditional reception, the Art Committee may plan a walking lecture to view the sculpture.

Karen Keefe will contact Joan Geary about a Fall 2019 exhibit. If she is not interested or able to exhibit, Vicky Bush-Joseph will contact Sarah Rehmer.

Other Business

Margaret Carsello Chiappetta told the committee that her friend Maria Grillo, another Hinsdale resident and art designer, is interested in joining the Art Committee.

The Art Committee agreed that the pieces donated by Hinsdale Gallery would not be added to the Library's permanent art collection. Per the donor's request, the pieces will be offered to Library staff.
