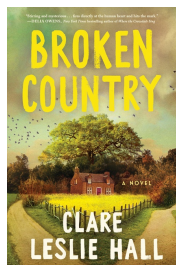

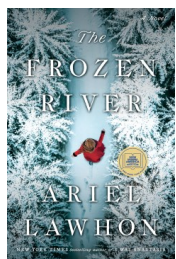

by Clare Leslie Hall

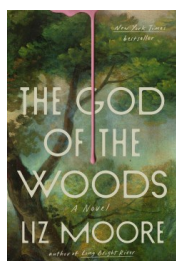

by Ariel Lawhon

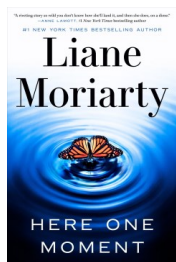

by Liz Moore

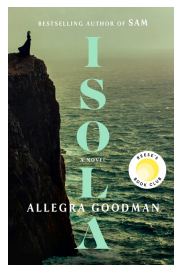

by Liane Moriarty

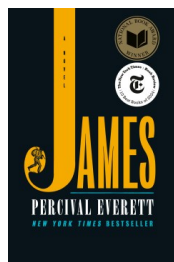
